Sports Field Maintenance Laborer

SUMMARY DESCRIPTION

Under direction of the Parks and Landscape Division Foreman, the employee performs semi-skilled maintenance work involving primarily baseball/softball fields and soccer fields, but also involves some maintenance work at other park facilities, such as skate park, bocce ball, tennis, and basketball courts, etc. This includes cleaning, repair and preparation of fields and courts. Work will occur mostly during weekday afternoons and may include some weekends.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

- Operate and use equipment associated with the maintenance of sports field, courts and recreation facilities.
- Scarify and drag ball fields.
- Water infields, fill in holes and rake as appropriate, including turf care.
- Check for safety and advise supervisor of any damage at facilities.
- Clean courts, install nets, and painting as needed.

Maintain polite, professional conduct and above average attendance and willingness to assume responsibility.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

The above description is of a general nature of work to be performed. It is not comprehensive. Employees can expect to be assigned other duties and responsibilities as needed.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS & ENVIRONMENTAL ELEMENTS

Strength and agility sufficient to lift up to 50 lbs with the ability to lift lesser weights repetitively, and to perform other physical activities needed to accomplish the essential functions of the position. This position also involves frequent standing, bending, stooping, squatting, lifting, kneeling, and reaching; Requires the employee to spend most of each day outside in the field under various weather conditions.

EDUCATION, TRAINING, AND EXPERIENCE:

- Valid California Driver's License with good driving record and ability to maintain good driving record.
- Occupational hazards and required safety precautions involved in work performed.
- Skilled in proper use of equipment and techniques for performing maintenance of ball fields, courts, and other recreation facilities; Prepare records and report
- Ability to communicate effectively in writing or orally with co-workers, supervisors, and general public; Understand and follow oral and written instructions.

COMPENSATION

The hourly rate for this part-time position has a salary range of **\$10.00—\$12.00** per hour and final compensation will be determined by level of experience. Sport Field Maintenance Laborer can expect to work approximately 20 hours per week; February through August. This is a non-exempt, "at-will" position limited to a maximum of 960 hours a year. Benefits are not provided for this position.
