#### 1. Call to Order

### 2. Unfinished Business

A. Welcome & Introductions

Welcomed Admin Sgt. Steve Perata. P.D's new rep to the Safety Cmte.

- B. Update:
  - 1. Facility Inspection Corrections- 2 items remain
    - Planning cabinets have been relocated (need to be anchored, as well as Christine's cabinets)
  - 2. ADA Transition Plan Update

Two proposals sought. Decided for Sally Swanson Architects Inc. The Plan will be phased. First phase includes:

- Self- Eval, Facilities- Senior center, Civic center, Cmnty parks & Crockett Park & Nunn Wilson parks, PROW's- areas adjacent to schools.
- Committee suggested to include Civic Center park & asked if the City owned buildings being leased have to be included (restaurants, pompei bldg.) & if the plan would help determine legal obligation to have trained staff to deal with disabled children, such as kiddos with Autism. These questions have been passed on to consultant.
- 3. Violence Prevention Inspection
  - Reviewed the inspection results conducted by Chief Thorsen
    - Identified the need to issue id badges to building staff
  - To make a personnel manual addition clarifying under which circumstances employees can refuse service if a hazardous situation exists
  - Evaluating Francisca's schedule/proactive measures to keep her safe
  - Training on this topic would be helpful, but does not take precedence over SDS/Global Harmonizing for which we will be due on 4/10/17

A. Safety Award Recognitions—

- C. Injury Reports -
  - Reviewed three injuries. 2 of 3 could have been prevented. Corrective actions have been taken including training & having a park gate fixed, as well as communicating that the gate could be locked in open position when misaligned to prevent injury until repair is completed.
  - Discussion regarding the gate continued. Police isn't always able to open. This would become a greater problem, as tournament season approaches. Subjects are now parking in the neighborhoods & walking to parks. Before it was easier to identify folks in the parking lot & Police would make contact & ask them to disperse. We will explore if signage can be installed that would allow for gates to stay open, but we would cite those there after hours & potentially tow. C.C. agreed to ask Bill how to do this. NM will discuss with Councilmember & City Manager.
