Resolution Establishing a Parking Fine Schedule

Background and Analysis

The City of Oakley Police Department has recently received inquiries regarding violations of the Oakley Municipal Code and the fines associated with parking violations.

After review of the Code, Staff has recognized that an updated resolution establishing the City's schedule of fines is needed. (The County's schedule was what was primarily being used). The adoption of a schedule of fines will allow Police Department staff to issue parking citations backed with a consistent schedule of fines that is available to the public and in line with similarly situated agencies throughout Contra Costa County.

Fiscal Impact

None. The schedule includes the same fines that have been charged.

Recommendation

Staff recommends approval of the Parking Fine Resolution.
