

The City of Oakley Youth Advisory Council presents the first Oakley's Got Talent Competition on Saturday, May 20th from 5:30 - 6:30 at Freedom High School football field located at 1050 Neroly Rd and we are looking for performers!

If you sing, dance, play an instrument, or have a special hidden talent then check it out! Individuals and groups are welcome. All acts interested in performing must complete this application (a waiver is required for all members of multi-person groups).

All performances must be family friendly, performances are monitored for use of inappropriate lyrics, gestures and dance moves. Performers are required to perform the same act in dress rehearsal and performance. Dress rehearsal is mandatory, and will be on April 26th at Oakley city hall.

Rules

- Performances are limited to 5 minutes in length and must be age 6 and up.
- Performers must live in or be enrolled in school in Oakley. (Non-residents may participate if they are in a group where over 50% of the members reside or are enrolled in Oakley schools)
- All performance attire and/ or costumes must be deemed appropriate by the panel of judges (performers with inappropriate attire will not be permitted to perform)
- If the performer is singing or rapping background music must be INSTRUMENTAL only.
- Music for the performance must be provided by April 19th.
- Performers are required to perform the same act in dress rehearsal and performance
- Dress rehearsal is mandatory, and will be on April 26th at Oakey city hall. If performers do not attend dress rehearsal they will not be permitted to perform.
- · Auditions will be held on March 8th at 5 pm at Oakley city hall
