In the event DWD's contractor performs the work in Bid Items 29, 30 and 31, DWD's contractor shall be responsible for the AC patch paving around the valve cans. City's contractor shall not be entitled to any additional time extension or compensation, including overhead or profit, in the event any of Bid Items 29, 30 and 31 are removed from the project scope and the amounts entered in the Bid Schedule for the remainder of the work shall remain unchanged. City shall notify City's contractor if it will be removing any of the items from the scope of work within ten (10) working days after the Notice of Reword.
