Line-up Training

402.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

- (a) Line-up training is generally conducted at the beginning of the officer's assigned shift. Line-up provides an opportunity for important exchange between employees and supervisors. A supervisor generally will conduct Line-up; however officers may conduct Line-up for training purposes with supervisor approval.
- (b) Line-up should accomplish, at a minimum, the following basic tasks:
 - Briefing officers with information regarding daily patrol activity, with particular attention given to unusual situations and changes in the status of wanted persons, stolen vehicles, and major investigations
 - 2. Notifying officers of changes in schedules and assignments
 - 3. Notifying officers of new General Orders or changes in General Orders
 - 4. Reviewing recent incidents for training purposes
 - 5. Providing training on a variety of subjects

402.2 PREPARATION OF MATERIALS

(a) The supervisor conducting Line-up is responsible for preparation of the materials necessary for a constructive briefing. Supervisors may delegate this responsibility to a subordinate officer in his or her absence or for training purposes.

402.3 RETENTION OF LINE-UP TRAINING RECORDS

(a) Line-up training materials and a curriculum or summary shall be forwarded to the Training Sergeant for inclusion in training records, as appropriate.
