

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that on **July 18, 2023** at 6:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, the Planning Commission of the City of Oakley will hold a Public Hearing at the Council Chambers located at 3231 Main Street, Oakley, CA 94561 for the purposes of considering an item as described below:

**Project Name:** 4601 Rose Avenue Tentative Parcel Map (TPM 01-23)

Project Location: 4601 Rose Avenue, Oakley, CA 94561

**Request:** Application by Lynnda Mori ("Applicant") requesting approval of a Tentative Parcel Map (TPM 01-23) to subdivide an approximately 1-acre residential parcel into two distinct parcels ("Project"). Parcel A would encompass an area of 30,654 square feet, while Parcel B would cover 9,211 square feet. The property currently has two existing residences, and this subdivision would result in a lot for each residence. This application does not include the construction of any new structures on the site. The site is located at 4601 Rose Avenue and is zoned R-6 (Single Family Residential) District. APN 035-190-017.
